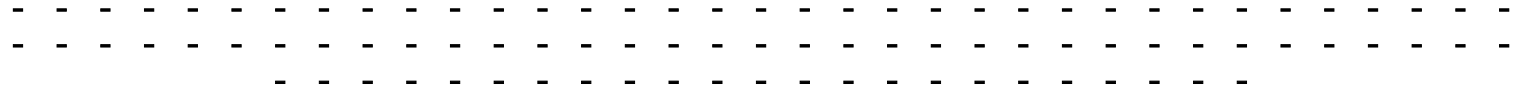

Dress Code
